

Board of Commissioners Minutes
January 22, 2018

Due to lack of a quorum there was no meeting of the Board of Commissioners this evening. However, the members of the Board who were present did listen to comments/concerns/questions from members of the public.

Questions from the Public

Ken Ayers, 19 Jakes Lane, noted a thank you to the District for sending out a reminder notice to drip faucets to prevent at risk pipes from freezing.

Kristin Ayers, 19 Jake Lane, requested an update on the water contamination issue. L. Woods noted that the updates coming from staff and others is encouraging. Kristin Ayers questioned the effect of any agreement with SGPP on the next generation of contaminants. L. Woods noted that the Board is confident that the current discussions are broad enough to include these chemicals. He noted that these future contaminants are not being ignored.

Ken Ayers questioned the results of a discussion regarding a filtration system test and whether this will happen. R. Miner noted that this possible filtration system will be brought back to the Board. L. Woods noted that he was not convinced that there was enough information for this to be beneficial to the District in the short term. He noted that the Board is very cautious about committing public money, but that this system is not out of the realm of possibility.

Since this meeting was not considered a meeting of the Board of Commissioners another meeting will held be by the Board on Monday, January 29, 2018 at 5:00 PM. This will be a regular Board of Commissioners meeting. L. Woods noted that this will be a legally posted meeting.
