**PUBLIC HEARING**

Chairman Provencher explained the purpose of the Public Hearing was to allow public input regarding:

**Merrimack Village District acceptance of grant money from the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services PFAS Remediation Grant Fund in the amount of \$3,369,375**

Notice of the Public Hearing was posted on the Merrimack Village District website ([www.MVDWATER.org](http://www.MVDWATER.org)), the Merrimack Town Hall, Public Library, and at the Merrimack Town Post Office.

**Merrimack Village District acceptance of grant money from the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services PFAS Remediation Grant Fund for Wells 2, 3, 7 and 8 in the amount of \$3,369,375**

Business Manager J. Lavoie explained that MVD applied for PFAS Remediation Loan funding. MVD was planning to refinance at the same or better rate for a loan in the amount of \$9,219,024. The PFAS Remediation Loan Fund has offered a grant in the amount of \$3,369,375. The grant will need to be accepted prior to disbursement.
